

UNCG Community Partners Training – Eligibility Requirements

“Who Should Complete This Community Partner Research Ethics Training?”

*Below are eligibility questions to ensure appropriate Community Partners are utilizing this training to fulfill their human subject research training requirement. This form is **NOT** intended for faculty/staff/students to use as a substitute for IRB-required Citi training. UNCG faculty/staff/students and faculty/staff/students at external universities/colleges are not eligible for this training*

This form can be completed by either the UNCG PI or by the community partner.

*Community partners must meet **both** of the following criteria:*

- ☐ Is the community partner collaborating with a Lead Researcher/Principal Investigator to complete research in the community?
- ☐ Is the community partner a member of a Community Organization or Agency or a member of the community in which the research will be conducted?

If yes, what is the name of the Community Organization, Community or Agency you are a member of:

*Community partners must meet **one** of the following criteria:*

- ☐ Is the community partner consenting people in the community to participate in human subjects research?
- ☐ Is the community partner observing and recording information about human subjects?
- ☐ Is the community member collecting private information about human subjects?
- ☐ Is the community partner using, studying or analyzing identifiable private information or specimens provided by another institution or investigator?
- ☐ Is the community partner using data collected from human subjects for research purposes?

If UNCG IRB determines the community partner is eligible for a community partners training, then additional instructions will be given to the UNCG PI, that will outline next steps to complete the required human subjects research training.

Once complete, the UNCG PI will need to submit this form to the UNCG IRB by attaching to their Cayuse IRB protocol. You can also email ORI@uncg.edu if you need the form approved prior to submitting your cayuse protocol.

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
